Sanford Health & Lake Region LPN Apprenticeship

This eleven-month LPN certificate program includes both classroom study and hands on experience in caring for patients as an LPN Apprentice under the supervision of a Registered Nurse (RN) in a Sanford Health Clinic or Hospital in North Dakota.

This is a partnership between LRSC and Sanford Health.

Eligibility:

- Must be accepted into Lake Region State College
 (https://app.applyyourself.com/AYApplicantLogin/fl_ApplicantConnectLogin.asp?id=NDUSLRSC)
- Must be accepted into the Dakota Nurse Program through Lake Region State College (https://www.lrsc.edu/nursing)
- Must be a new student in order to be eligible for this apprenticeship program
- Must be on the ND Board of Nursing UAP registry
- Commit to working for Sanford Health as a nurse for 3 years in a full time status after completion of program and accepting a position
- Must maintain a GPA that meets program requirements and show forward progression through the program of study
- Must be eligible for employment at Sanford Health and able to pass any pre-employment screening requirements
 - Must be in good standing with Sanford Health if internal employee

Program Description:

- Sanford pays for the cost of the educational program, payment is made directly to LRSC
- Recipients agree to work for Sanford Health as an LPN or RN for a period of 3 years in a fulltime status, after successful graduation and licensure
- Students work in a paid, LPN Apprentice position with Sanford while in school
 - Wage starts at \$17.00 and will progressively increase while progressing in the program
- Must complete 2000 hours in their Apprentice position prior to being promoted into an LPN position
- Recipients are not eligible for any Sanford Health Hiring Bonus being offered at the time of employment
- Loan forgiveness will begin upon receipt of permanent LPN license and employment in applicable position at Sanford
- Failure to comply with any of the requirements of this program will result in repayment of the loan with interest

Steps to Take:

- Be accepted to Lake Region State College
- Be accepted into the Dakota Nurse Program for Fall 2023
- Apply to the Sanford LPN Apprentice Program (Deadline August 1) https://app.smartsheet.com/b/form/901b44e99730420a8903763552cf5835
- Apply for the Sanford Health LPN Apprentice Position (your placement will be determined closer to start date)

STEPS TO COMPLETE:

- 1. Complete the UAP application for the ND Board of Nursing (https://www.ndbon.org/download_resource.asp?id=592)
 - a. Use attached form with Job Category and Employment Setting sections completed for you
 - b. Attach \$60 fee payable to the ND Board of Nursing
- 2. Schedule Fingerprinting appointment
 - a. Locations https://www.nbinformation.com/locations/lawEnforcement/ND.php
 - b. Fee for fingerprinting will vary depending upon agency charges.
- 3. Complete Criminal History Record Check Request and submit with Fingerprints with fee
 - a. Criminal History Record Check form (https://attorneygeneral.nd.gov/sites/ag/files/documents/CHR-Request-SFN60688.pdf)
 - b. Submit Completed fingerprint cards (from the law enforcement agency)
 - i. TWO completed fingerprint cards if ink and roll or ONE completed fingerprint card if electronic. Do not fold fingerprint cards.
 - c. Money Order or Cashier Check for \$41.25, with a current date, and must be made PAYABLE TO BCI. (No personal checks accepted)
- 4. If applying as a student technician (you are), must also submit a Verification of Enrollment Form (https://www.ndbon.org/download_resource.asp?id=564) to be completed by Lake Region representative
