



Overview:

The North Dakota Space Grant Consortium supports several prestigious scholarships for students enrolled in STEM or STEM Education programs at affiliate North Dakota colleges and universities. These NDSGC Scholarships include the following funding opportunities. Each scholarship program is merit-based and holds unique eligibility criteria.

- <u>Lillian Goettler Scholarship</u>
- Pearl I. Young Scholarship
- Tribal College Scholarship
- <u>Undergraduate Scholarship</u>
- Transfer Scholarship
- ND Vision Services/School for the Blind (NDVS/SB) Scholarship

Eligibility:

Applicants for Undergraduate and Tribal College Scholarships must be U.S. Citizens who are enrolled in an NDSGC Affiliate College / University. The student must be in good academic standing and must be pursuing a degree in or related to the areas of science, technology, engineering, or mathematics (STEM) or STEM Education.

Description of Undergraduate Scholarships:

The Office of Financial Aid and STEM departments at each college / university will determine the number of scholarships awarded and their internal due dates for applications for each academic year. Scholarship awards are limited to \$2,500 per student.

Application Procedure:

Applicants should submit the following to their respective Office of Financial Aid:

Mayville State University students: Please submit your application and letter of recommendation to Dr. Bob Miess (<u>robert.miess@mayvillestate.edu</u>). Deadline is **November 14**, **2025**.
