**College degree credit courses** are courses for students to earn academic credit that may be applied to a degree.

The college courses are for a student enrolled in and attending high school in grades 10, 11, and 12 seeking postsecondary credit prior to high school graduation. Students enrolling in a college course must have a high school GPA of 2.0 or higher and are limited to 11 credits per semester.
