

# High School Graduate Study

November 21, 2024

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## Purpose

Given the close physical proximity of Devils Lake High School (DLHS) and other area high schools to Lake Region State College, connecting with students who graduate from these high schools is a priority in our recruiting strategy. As we discuss how best to assess the success of recruiting efforts, one measure identified is to do an annual comparison of the percentage of DLHS graduates who enroll at LRSC. Another measure is to compare the number of graduates from area high schools who attend LRSC.

## Process

This study tracks the:

1. number of DLHS graduates who graduated in the spring semester and enrolled at LRSC the following fall semester;
2. program these students enrolled in at LRSC;
3. higher education institutions DLHS graduates enrolled at if other than LRSC; and
4. number of students from area high schools who graduated in the spring semester and enrolled at LRSC the following fall semester.

## Results

### *DLHS Graduates to LRSC*

The table below shows the number of DLHS graduates who graduated in the spring semester and enrolled at LRSC the following fall semester.
