Information Security Apprenticeship

Salary: Minimum starting annual salary \$40,000 per year/full-time, exempt (eligible for overtime), benefited position in the 4000 broadband

Employer paid tuition and books for the apprenticeship program at LRSC

Location: Grand Forks, ND (A hybrid telework option may be available after completion of the initial training period).

Description:

This position provides administrative and technical assistance in the management of information security. Responsibilities include implementation and support for security technologies, vulnerability management, security training and awareness, remediation of security issues, and participation in incident response. This position will participate in the LRSC apprenticeship program which will lead to an Associate of Applied Science in Information Technology Degree with a concentration in Cyber Security. This position reports to the Director of Information Security for the North Dakota University System (NDUS) /Core Technology Services (CTS) and serves CTS and NDUS campuses.

The anticipated start date for this position is October 1, 2024 (or sooner) and coursework may begin with Spring semester in January 2025.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Acceptance in the LRSC apprenticeship program & agreement to the terms of that program.

- Security or technology industry certifications (e.g. SANS GIAC, CompTIA Security+, or similar)

Applicants should apply online at <https://cts.ndus.edu/about/careers/> and upload a cover letter **specifically addressing the job qualifications**, and a current resume. Professional references may be requested.

Applicants who are veterans and eligible to claim veteran's preference must include Form DD214 with the application for employment; claims for disabled veteran's preference must include Form DD214 and a letter less than one year old from the Department of Veterans' Affairs indicating disability; claims for preference as the eligible spouse of a disabled or deceased veteran must include Form DD214, a marriage certificate and a letter less than one year old from the Department of Veterans' Affairs indicating disability, or the veteran's death certificate. Due to access to restricted information, the successful candidate will be required to complete a satisfactory criminal background check.

Applicants must be eligible to work in the U.S. and I-9 employment certification is required at hire. There is no sponsorship available for this position.
